<i>Installation/Dedicated Support</i>
<i>Duties:</i> Supports with the initial ASTS® server SQL database, web files, IIS, folder permissions and other setup requirements plus testing and related training.
<i>Minimum Requirements:</i> High School Diploma with no experience required.

<i>Data Entry/Import/Conversion Support</i>
<i>Duties:</i> Supports with preparing, editing, reformatting, converting, importing, or manual entry process of migrating data into the ASTS® database.
<i>Minimum Requirements:</i> High School Diploma with no experience required.

<i>SUBJECT MATTER EXPERT</i>
<i>Duties:</i> Provides technical leadership, direction, and special skills for complex tasks and portions of tasks that require unique or uncommon levels of expertise related to specific functional subject matter. Ensures that work within area of responsibility is complete, meets customer requirements, and is of high quality.
<i>Qualifications:</i> A Subject Matter Expert is a highly skilled individual who has acknowledged unique or uncommon technology and/or functional expertise in specific areas that are essential for the performance of a particular task.
